



CyberOptics Corporation Management Policy Export Compliance Policy Statement

CyberOptics Corporation and all of its subsidiaries (the "Company") have a significant international presence and therefore it is the Company's policy that all exports of products, technology and information comply with all applicable export laws. Company employees must be aware that, in addition to shipping goods or technology from any Company facility worldwide to a foreign country (directly or indirectly), exports can include transferring information to foreign nationals by verbal communications (telephone or in-person), e-mail, training, presentations and customer visits. Under no circumstance will exports be made contrary to the Company's export control policies or applicable export laws.

The Company is dedicated to providing sufficient time, money, and personnel in order to prevent illegal exports and to adhere to all applicable export control laws and regulations. Special care will be taken to prevent export transactions with entities involved in production or use of weapons of mass destruction and to prevent transactions with entities that are prohibited by the U.S. Government from participating in export transactions.
